A REMINDER

RE: KING HARBOR MARINA BOAT SLIPS

When the city of Redondo Beach was developing King Harbor, a need was felt for a strong, viable yacht club. Two organizations, Redondo Harbor Yacht Club and Win'ard Yacht Club were operating in the area. They joined to form King Harbor Yacht Club in 1961.

As an inducement to lease the club's present site and to relinquish ten-existing slip rights on Mole B, the Redondo Beach City Council through the yacht club's long-term lease with King Harbor Marina, granted the club and its members:

1. The right of first refusal to available slips in the marina.
2. A ten percent discount if slip rent is prepaid to the marina for one year.

These benefits are available to all KHYC members in good standing.

The KHYC Member's waiting list for King Harbor Marina boat slips is kept in the club office for your inspection. As you have been admitted as a new member, should you like to be included on the list, please contact the club manager. Since the list is quite long, at this time we can discuss your requirements and prospects of future availability.

KHYC PROVISIONAL MEMBERSHIP

King Harbor Yacht Club realizes that the \$2,200.00 initial financial commitment necessary to join the Club represents an unattractive level of risks to some potential members who are not completely certain that they will find membership to be worth the cost. We have developed a method to permit such potential members to sample the benefits of membership at reduced initial cost. The Board of Directors of KHYC at its October 1996 meeting approved an extended guest status for potential new members of the Club, who will be designated as "Provisional Members".

Provisional Members will have most of the privileges of Regular or Dual Members. They will be given keys and allowed access to and use of the Clubhouse, docks and hoist located at King Harbor Yacht Club and the Club facilities located at Little Fisherman Cove on Catalina Island. They will not be eligible to store a boat in the KHYC dry storage yards or to enter the waiting list for such storage. They also will not be eligible to submit an application for the Slip Waiting List. Their access privileges will be extended to their immediate family members (spouse and children) and, in the event they are not married, to one designated long term "significant other" and they will be permitted to host 4 other guests in KHYC facilities. Any purchases from the bar, galley or merchandise displays and all fees for member paid Club events will be on a cash basis. Provisional Members will not be permitted to fly the Club burgee and will not be extended reciprocal privileges by other yacht clubs.

Individuals interested in this trial relationship with KHYC will be required to submit an application equivalent to that for permanent membership status and to pass the normal review of the Membership Committee and obtain approval of the Board of Directors. There will be an initial charge of \$250.00 to become a Provisional Member, and a monthly charge equal to that paid by Regular or Duals Members (currently \$112.00 per month). After twelve months of Provisional Membership, Provisional Members will be required to either join KHYC as a Regular or Dual Member (without requiring further review by the Membership Committee or Board of Directors), or to sever their relationship with the Club. Provisional Members electing to join KHYC at the end of their twelve months trial period may apply their initial \$250.00 charge to the amounts due on the Regular or Dual membership payment plan they elect.
