KHYC to CBYC (Spinnaker #4)
Fourth RACE OF THE KHYC SPINNAKER SERIES
SATURDAY, June 9, 2012

RULES: This race will be governed by the 2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing. The prescriptions of USSA and the Sailing Instructions will apply. RRS Rule 82 will not apply to this event. This race is a Category 3 event.

ENTRIES: Entries from members of SCYA affiliate Yacht Clubs who hold a current PHRF certificate will be accepted at KHYC from 0900 until 1030 on race day. Advance registration by mail must be received at KHYC by June 8th. There will be a \$15.00 entry fee.

VENUE: This is a point to point race **starting** at KHYC "S" Mark (Santa Monica Bay) and **finishing** at CB Mark "82" (Los Angeles Harbor) and the RC boat. Refer to the 2012 KHYC Race Mark Guide and the attached Race Chart, as well as, the Sailing Instructions available at the Registration Desk on Race Day.

DIVISIONS: Based on the entrants in the 1st race of the series, PHRF class splits, using PHRF Area-B Buoy ratings, are as follows: A (137 or less) - B (138 or higher). This is a Category 3 race.

SKIPPER'S MEETING: A 1015 Skippers Meeting will be held on race day at KHYC.

START: In the vicinity of "S" mark. The first warning will be at 1155. Subsequent class starts are at 30 minute intervals. Boats must sail by the RC boat prior to the 1st warning signal of their class in order to be recognized as a starter.

FINISH: The finish will be between a committee boat and the mark CB "82" inside LA Harbor.

PENALTY SYSTEM: Rule 44.1 is changed so that the two turn penalty is replaced by the one turn penalty. Rule 44.3 will not apply.

SCORING: The Low Point scoring system of RRS Appendix A.4 will apply as a single race event. PHRF **OWC** Course ratings will apply with Time-On-Time scoring for this race.

TROPHIES: Individual trophies will be awarded at CBYC following the race. The perpetual trophy for the KHYC to CBYC will be presented at the annual awards event.

FACILITIES: All participants are welcome at the KHYC Clubhouse before the race. KHYC's galley will be open on the Friday before the race for lunch between 11:30am and 2:00pm and hearty appetizers will be served at the bar from 6:00 to 9:00pm. Saturday morning the galley is open for breakfast beginning at 8:30am. There will be a cook-your-own-steak dinner at CBYC on Saturday night. Please contact Dixon Hall at CBYC regarding dinner Saturday night.

DOCKING and SLIPS: Participating boats are welcome to use the KHYC overnight guest dock and hoist facilities; the guest dock is available on a first-come, first serve basis. Call the KHYC Office for inquiries concerning the guest dock. Additional slips may be obtained from King Harbor Marina at a discounted overnight rate for registered race participants at (310) 376-6926.

Slips at CBYC are available on Saturday for a short-term stay as well as overnight. If you need a berthing following the race, please contact Dixon Hall in advance with your boat length and draft as well as your intention to stay overnight.
