FIRST RACE OF THE KHYC SPINNAKER SERIES

An ASMBYC High Point Event
Saturday, February 06, 2016

RULES: This event will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing. The prescriptions of USSA and the event Sailing Instructions shall apply. RRS Rule 82 will not apply to this event. This is a US Nearshore event with paragraph 3.8.2 modified to only require any type of VHF radio.

ENTRIES: Spinnaker classes are open to members of SCYA affiliated Yacht Clubs or Associations who hold a current PHRF rating certificate. PHRF Non-Spinnaker offsets will not be applied. Cruisers, Multihulls, Martin 242s, Vipers and other one design classes are invited; at least three entries will constitute a class. Cruising class boats must have a current ASMBYC Cruiser rating. One Design and Multihull entries must fulfill the eligibility requirements of their class. Entrants shall complete the online entry process at <http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/11668>. Registration can be performed at KHYC from 0900 until 1030 on race day. The entry fee is \$20.00, with a \$3 late fee for entries on race day, or \$90.00 for the entire series.

VENUE: The race area will be per the current KHYC Mark Guide, the Sailing Instructions and the Course Chart available at regattanetwork.com or at the Registration Desk on Race Day.

DIVISIONS: PHRF class splits will be posted at KHYC, by 1000 on race day. PHRF Area-B2 Buoy ratings will be used to establish classes. The splits established for this race will apply to the entire series

SCHEDULE OF RACES: There will be one race of approximately 11.1 NM.

The course will be: **Start @ K – F – B – F – H – T – A – G – W - Finish ? DBT**

STARTS: In the vicinity of "Y" mark. The first warning for "B" boats will be at 1155. "B" boats will start at 1200. "A" boats' warning will be at 1225, start at 1230. (Note: The Multihulls and One Designs will start in the interval between the "B" start at 1200 and the "A" warning signal at 1225). Boats must sail by the RC boat prior to the warning signal for their class in order to be recognized as a starter.

FINISH: The finish is just inside the harbor entrance between an orange flag on the RC boat and the Redondo Beach East Jetty Light (#2) at the harbor entrance

PENALTY SYSTEM: Rule 44.1 is changed so that the two turn penalty is replaced by the one turn penalty. Rule 44.3 will not apply.

SCORING: The Low Point scoring system of RRS Appendix A.4 will apply as a single race event. PHRF Area B2 RLC ratings will apply with TOT scoring for this race.

TROPHIES: Individual trophies will be awarded at KHYC following the race. The Marold Eyestone Perpetual trophy (PHRF A&B) will be awarded at the KHYC annual awards event.

FACILITIES: All participants are welcome in the Club before and after the race. Post-race hors d'oeuvres will be served. Participating boats are welcome to use the KHYC overnight guest dock and hoist facilities. Call the KHYC Office for inquiries concerning the Guest Dock.
