CHRISTMAS REGATTA - Notice of Race
PHRF, NON-SPINNAKER, MULTI-HULL & ONE-DESIGN BOATS

SATURDAY, DECEMBER 5, 2015
(LAST RACE OF THE 2015 RACING SEASON)

DIVISIONS: Three (3) boats will constitute a class. PHRF splits and order of start will be posted at KHYC by 1045 on race day.

ENTRIES: Entries from members of SCYA affiliate Yacht Clubs who hold valid ratings will be accepted at KHYC between 0900 and 1030 on race day. Registration by mail must be received at KHYC by Wednesday, December 2nd. There will be a \$20.00 entry fee.

COURSES: Courses will be included in the Sailing Instructions available at registration. All Fleets will race three races, if time and weather permit. There will be no throw-outs.

STARTS: In the vicinity of "S" mark. The first warning will be at 1155. The order of start may change for the second or third race. Observe all placard and/or flag changes on the Committee boat.

FINISHES: The same as the start line.

RULES: The race will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of USSA, Class Rules and the Sailing Instructions available at the Registration table. RRS 82 will not apply to this event. Boats that do not finish must notify the Race Committee as soon as possible after retiring. Competitors must sail by the Race Committee boat on a starboard tack prior to the first warning to be classified as a starter.

PROTESTS: Protesting boats shall fly a red flag, notify the protested boat and notify the RC when finishing. A written protest (forms available at KHYC) must be filed within 45 minutes after the RC boat arrives at the front dock.

Scoring: The Low Point scoring system of RRS Appendix A.4 will apply. Buoy ratings and Time on Time handicap scoring will be used.

TROPHIES: Trophies will be awarded at KHYC following the race. **There will be a prize for the crew showing the most Holiday spirit.** This is the last regatta of the season, so all participants are urged to share in the after-race festivities at the Club.

FACILITIES: All participants are welcome in the Club before and after the regatta. Participating boats are welcome to use the KHYC overnight guest dock and hoist facilities. Call the KHYC Office for inquiries concerning the Guest Dock.
