Substitute for Santa Barbara Island to port Race

4th RACE OF THE SPINNAKER SERIES
A CATEGORY 3 EVENT

DIVISIONS: Class splits as established for the first race of the series using Buoy ratings are as follows: A-(0 - 149), B-(150 - Up). **RLC ratings** apply to this race.

ENTRIES: Entries from members of SCYA affiliate yacht clubs who hold valid ratings will be accepted at KHYC from 0900 to 1030 on race day. The entry fee is \$15.00.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS will be available at registration on race day.

COURSE: From the start, "A" boats will take "C" mark to starboard, El Segundo Buoy, ES2 to port, Private mark FI Y 4S to port, Y28 mark to port, "G" mark to port, "W" mark to port, finish inside Redondo Beach Harbor entrance.

"B" boats will take "C" mark to starboard, Private mark FI Y 4S to port, Y28 mark to port, "G" mark to port, "W" mark to port, finish inside Redondo Beach Harbor entrance.

START: In the vicinity of "S" mark. The first warning will be at 1155. Boats must sail by the Race Committee boat prior to the first warning in order to be recognized as a starter.

FINISH: The finish line will be between the light on the East jetty at the King Harbor entrance and the Committee boat. If the Committee boat is not on station boats shall take their times when the Jetty light bears 100 degrees off the starboard beam. Notify Scoring Committee at 310-488-0207 or 310-375-7619, (voice mail) before Noon on Sunday, June 7th.

RULES: The 2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing, USSA prescriptions and the Sailing Instructions will apply. Boats that do not finish must notify the Scoring Committee at 310-488-0207 as soon as possible after retiring.

PROTESTS: Protesting boats shall fly a red flag, notify the protested boat immediately and notify the Race Committee when finishing. A written protest (forms available at KHYC) must be filed by 1200 on Sunday, June 7th. Hearings will be held before 1800 on Sunday.

TROPHIES: Trophies will be awarded at the annual Awards Event at the end of the year.

HOSPITALITY: All participants are welcome in the Clubhouse before the race. Participating boats are welcome to use the KHYC guest dock and hoist facilities. Call the KHYC Office for inquiries concerning the Guest Dock.
