Centerboard Regatta Sailing Instructions KHYC – May 18th 2002

1) Rules - This event will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2001-2004.

2) Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 The event is open to boats from SCYA affiliated yacht clubs and recognized handicap racing fleets.
- 2.2 All boats must conform to their PHRF certificates, with the exception of Portsmouth rated boats, which must conform to the current U.S. Sailing Portsmouth ratings.
- 2.3 Registration may be completed by mail or at KHYC by 10:00 A.M. on the morning of the race.
- 3) Notices to competitors Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located on the first floor in front of the Race Committee Room.
- 4) Changes in Sailing Instructions Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted before 10:00 A.M. and immediately after the skippers meeting on the day it will take effect. (Changes to the Olson class rules will also be posted).
- 5) Signals made ashore Signals made ashore will be displayed on the KHYC flag pole located on the East patio of the clubhouse. If the postponement signal (AP) is displayed the warning signal will be made no sooner than one hour after the AP is lowered. This changes the RRS 2001-2004 Race Signals.
- 6) Schedule of races Six races are scheduled with the first warning signal at noon. If all six are completed, there will be one throwout. Multiple horns may be sounded prior to the first warning of each race. Three races will constitute a regatta.
- 7) Signals on the Race Committee Boat Starting signals will conform to rule 26 of the 2001-2004 racing rules of sailing. For the first race, classes will start in the following order:

Class Flag
Multi-hull U
Portsmouth V

- 8) The racing course The racing area will be in the vicinity of "K" Mark as identified in KHYC Course Chart 2002. The course and first mark will be displayed on a board from the committee boat. See Attachment "A" for the courses.
- 9) Marks Marks are spar buoys in the approximate positions defined on KHYC Course Chart 2001 and/or large inflatable bouys.

10) The Start

- 10.1 Races will be started using rule 26 with classes starting at five-minute intervals. The committee will attempt to keep all start & restart times at five-minute clock intervals.
- 10.2 The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the race committee boat and a staff with an orange flag floating to **STARBOARD** of the race committee boat.
- 10.3 Boats whose preparatory signal has not been made shall keep clear of the starting area and all boats whose preparatory signal has been made.
- 11) The finish The finish line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the race committee boat and \underline{K} mark to \underline{PORT} of the race committee boat.
