FORMAT: A Small Boat Arbitrary Handicap Open race using the KHYC Portsmouth Handicap System.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all properly equipped boats 20 feet LOA and under, but not less than 10 feet LOA, possessing a recognized Portsmouth type handicap number, whose owners are members of SCYA Yacht Clubs. Boats not having a Portsmouth number are invited to enter. The regular KHYC entry forms are available at KHYC with an Entry Fee of \$10.00 payable to KHYC for members of USSA and \$13.00 for non-members. All boats must be equipped with compass, suitable bailer, painter and paddle. Each member participating shall conform to Coast Guard life preserver requirements during the race. Failure to comply will be grounds for disqualification.

ENTRIES: Entries will be accepted by mail and at KHYC until 1030 on the day of the race. Additional starting numbers will be issued for boats, provided a sufficient amount of race data is made available to the race committee prior to the day of the race. Entries will not be accepted after 1030 on Race Day.

RULES: The current Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of USSA, the instructions of this announcement, and sailing instructions available at registration will prevail.

STARTS: The race will be an "INVERTED START" race. All Portsmouth number corrections will be made before the start of the race. The order of start and the course to be sailed is indicated on the sailing instructions and will be posted at KHYC on Race Day. The start will be at 1200.

TROPHIES: Trophies will be presented at the conclusion of the day. In addition to overall trophies, class trophies will be awarded in accordance with KHYC policy.

PERPETUAL TROPHY: A perpetual trophy has been deeded in memory of Neal Anderson. Recognizing his interest in the Junior Program, and his annual involvement in the Cecil R. King Race, the trophy will be awarded to the first boat to finish, whose skipper is under nineteen years of age.

ENTERTAINMENT: All participants are welcome in the Club during the regatta. The bar will be open at 1500 on race day..
