# **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

#### 1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the "RULES" as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing.

Only one man and one woman will be allowed on board.

Spinnakers will not be allowed.

Only one headsail may be used.

#### 2 ENTRIES

Competitors may enter by mailing entry form with entry fees of \$25 for USSA members and \$35 for non-USSA members. Or \$10.00 and \$13.00 per individual races. Or by delivering a completed entry form and paying the entry fee to King Harbor Yacht Club before 1030 on race day.

### 3 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located outside the race committee room on the lower deck of the yacht club.

## 4 CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Any changes to the sailing instructions will be posted before 1000 on the day they take effect, except that any change to the schedule of races, will be posted by 2000 on the day before it take effect.

## 5 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

Signals made ashore will be displayed from the flagpole located in the east patio of KHYC. If a postponement is signaled ashore, the warning signal will be made not less than 1 hour after AP is lowered.

#### 6 RADIO COMMUNICATION

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

#### 7 SCHEDULE

The warning signal for the first start will be 1225 on each day.

#### **8 STARTING SYSTEM**

Race will be started in accordance with rule 26.

#### 9 STARTING LINE

The start line will be between an orange flag on the race committee beat in the vicinity of "S" mark and an orange flag on a staff off the port side of the committee boat.

REF: KHYC course chart 2001

Boats whose warning signal has not been made shall keep clear of the starting area.

#### 10 CLASS FLAGS

Class Flags will be:

PHRF A Code Flag "D"
PHRF B Code Flag "E"
PHRF C Code Flag "F"
Portsmouth Code Flag "K"

#### 11 COURSE

See Attachment "A"

#### 12 MARKS

The Mid-channel buoy at the entrance of the harbor must be taken to PORT. The Bell Buoy (mark G) must be taken to port.

#### 13 FINISH LINE

The finish line will be between an orange flag on the race committee boat and the red light on the end of the seawall in front of the yacht club.

Sunset rule: A boat not finishing by sunset will be scored DNF.

#### 14 PROTESTS

Protests shall be delivered to King Harbor Race Committee on protest forms available at KHYC. Within 45 minutes after the Race Committee boat reaches the dock.

#### 15 SCORING

The Low Point System of Appendix "A" of the racing rules will apply.

#### 16 TROPHIES

Trophies will be awarded as soon as possible after racing.

The Maureen Cash Memorial Trophy will be awarded at the KHYC annual awards dinner.
