## TRANS HARBOR RACE - 2nd RACE OF THE SPINNAKER SERIES SUNDAY, MAY 6, 2001

(A High Point Event - Category 4)

**<u>DIVISIONS:</u>** Based on the entrants in the 1st race of the series, class splits are as follows: A-(0-147)- B-(148-999).

ENTRIES: Entries from members of SCYA affiliate yacht clubs who hold valid ratings will be accepted at KHYC until 1000 on race day. There will be a \$13.00 entry fee for non-USSA members and \$10.00 for USSA members.

COURSE: From the start at "S" mark round "F" mark to starboard, then El Segundo Buoy "2ES" to port, then an inflatable mark, 3 NM from El Segundo Buoy on a heading of 235 degrees to port, then round "T" mark to starboard, then to finish at "S" mark. Start, "F", "T" and finish marks are as per KHYC Course Chart #2001. Handicap distance approximately 16.0 NM.

STARTS: The race will be started by using the following signals. Times shall be taken from the visual signals; the absence of a sound signal shall be disregarded.

1155	Warning	Class flag or placard displayed	1 sound
1156	Preparatory	P, I, Z, Z with I, or Black Flag	1 sound
1159	Preparatory f		bruce prol

1200 Start - Class flag removed 1 sound
The warning signal for each succeeding class shall be made with or
after the starting signal of the preceding class.

Class flag for PHRF A will be International Code flag "D". Class flag for PHRF B will be International Code flag "E".

<u>FINISH</u>: The finish line is the same as the start line, unless altered by the Regatta Sailing Instructions. All boats will finish from the direction of the last mark.

RULES: The 2001-2004 Racing Rules of Sailing, USSA prescriptions and the racing rules on the back of KHYC Course Chart #2001 will apply. Boats must sail by the Race Committee boat in order to be recognized as a starter. Boats that do not finish must notify the Race Committee as soon as possible after retiring.

PROTESTS: Protesting boats shall fly a red flag, notify the protested boat immediately and notify the Race Committee when finishing. A written protest (forms available at KHYC) must be filed within 45 minutes after the Race Committee arrives at the front dock.

**TROPHIES:** Individual trophies will be awarded at KHYC following the race. Perpetual trophies will be presented at a later date.

**<u>FACILITIES:</u>** All participants are welcome in the Clubhouse before and after the race. Participating boats are welcome to use the KHYC guest dock and hoist facilities.
