2nd RACE OF THE SPINNAKER SERIES
A CATEGORY 4 EVENT - ASMBYC HIGH POINT RACE

DIVISIONS: Class splits are as follows: A-(0 - 149) - B-(150-999).

ENTRIES: Entries from members of SCYA affiliate yacht clubs who hold valid ratings will be accepted at KHYC from 0830 to 1030 on race day. The entry fee will be \$10.00.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS will be available at registration on race day.

COURSE: From the start at "S" mark round "F" mark to starboard, then El Segundo Buoy "2ES" to port, then an inflatable mark, approximately 2 NM from El Segundo Buoy on a heading of 235 degrees magnetic from 2ES, to port, at the approximate position of 33-53-57 No. and 188-29-48 W, then round "T" mark to starboard, then to finish at "S" mark. Marks, "S", "F", "T" are as per KHYC Course Chart #2006. The distance will be 14.6 NM.

START: In the vicinity of "S" mark as per the Sailing Instructions. Sail by the RC boat prior to the 1st warning signal in order to be recognized as a starter. The first warning will be at 1155.

FINISH: The finish line will be the same as the start line unless altered by the sailing instructions. All boats will finish from the direction of the last mark.

RULES: The 2005-2008 Racing Rules of Sailing, USSA prescriptions will apply. RLC ratings will apply. Boats that do not finish must notify the Race Committee as soon as possible after retiring. 'RRS' Rule 75.3 will not apply to this event.

PROTESTS: Protesting boats shall fly a red flag, notify the protested boat immediately and notify the Race Committee when finishing. A written protest (forms available at KHYC) must be filed within 45 minutes after the Race Committee arrives at the front dock.

TROPHIES: Individual trophies will be awarded at KHYC following the race. The Fishermen's Race Perpetual for the 2nd longest race in the Series will be presented at a later date.

HOSPITALITY: All participants are welcome in the Clubhouse before and after the race. Participating boats are welcome to use the KHYC guest dock and hoist facilities.
